

Firearms, ammunition, bladed weapons and bows at the stand

For safety reasons, please ensure the following regarding how exhibition items are accessible to visitors and how they are stored overnight:

- Firearms must not be operational. Each firearm must have either a chamber safety flag, trigger lock, a removed or cut firing pin, or otherwise be rendered non-functional as a display weapon. The purpose is to prevent visitors from using the firearm with their own ammunition.
- A representative must always be present at the stand during opening hours. They are responsible for safety, presenting the firearms, bladed weapons and bows, and monitoring visitors at the stand.
- Displayed firearms must be secured to a wall or structure with a durable steel cable threaded through the trigger guard. A plastic-coated 6 mm cable is recommended (4 mm steel inside the plastic coating). The coating provides flexibility and prevents wear on the firearm.
- No loose firearms in glass display cases.
- No live ammunition is allowed at the stands.
- Bladed weapons must be stored in a display case, stand, or under another protective cover/plexiglass.

Additional notes

- At the end of each day, ensure all firearms are locked and that bladed weapons and bows are stored in locked display cases or cabinets.
- Storing firearms in vehicles in the parking area is prohibited.
- The Erähalli and Beretta Arena are locked overnight; Erähalli has a security guard present throughout the night.

Sales of airguns and pre-assembled bows

The sale of airguns and pre-assembled bows is permitted at the stand under the following conditions:

- Packages must be sealed with a cable tie, duct tape, or similar.
- Customers must be instructed not to open the packages within the event area.
